



Pursuant to the article 82 of the Law on Local Self-Government (Official Gazette of Republiika Srpska number 97/16), article 89 of the Statute of the City of Prijedor (Official Gazette of the City of Prijedor, number: 12/77), pursuant to the article 6 of the Regulation on organizing the International Choir Festival “Zlana vila” (Official Gazette of the City of Prijedor number), the Mayor of the City of Prijedor – President of the Organizing Board brings

REGULATIONS

on Awards at the Zlatna vila International Choir Festival

Article 1

- (1) This Regulation regulates the name, number and type of awards and recognitions, the manner of its awarding as well as its form.

Article 2

- (1) At the Festival the following awards and recognitions are given:
 1. Plaque “Zlatna vila”;
 2. Medals “Zlatna vila”;
 3. Special recognitions;
 4. Charter “Award of Audience” and
 5. Participation diplomas.

Article 3

- (1) Awards from the article 2 of point 1-3 of this Regulation are given by the Jury of the Festival, the Charter “Award of Audience” is given by audience whilst the diplomas for participation are received by all participating choirs and conductors of the Festival as well as members of the Jury.

Article 4

- (1) The Plaque “Zlatna vila” is given to the choir that won the first place in competition for Grand Prix of the Festival.
- (2) This award consists of the plaque and sum of money of 2.500,00 Euros.
- (3) The Plaque “Zlatna vila” is handed by the Mayor of Prijedor.

Article 5

- (1) Choirs receive the Festival’s medals based on rates of the Festival Jury by the following table:
 - Bronze medal 70,00 to 79,99 rates
 - Silver medal 80,00 to 89,99 rates
 - Gold medal 90,00 to 100 rates
- (1) The Festival’s medals are handed by the Mayor of Prijedor.

Article 6

(1) For the specialness in certain elements of choral singing the Festival Jury can award the following special recognitions for:

1. The best performed Old Master work;
2. The best performed contemporary work;
3. The best performed domestic work (depending the country the choir comes from;)
4. The best performed composition from spiritual music;
5. Overall stage performance and
6. Conducting.

(2) In special occasions, the Jury of the Festival can give a decision on awarding one more special recognition.

(3) Special recognitions are handed in printing form and they do not imply the money part of the award.

(4) Special Festival's recognitions are handed by the President of the Festival's Jury.

Article 7

(1) The Charter "Award of Audience" is awarded to the choir that collected the highest average rates within competition for the Award of Audience.

(2) In case two or more choirs have the same average rates, the Award is handed the choir that is better rated in competition for the awards of the Jury.

(3) Audience votes right after the performance, on the first and second festival's evening, and the voting ballot is the ticket with printed titles of choirs on the back. Audience votes by rating the performance of each choir from 1 to 5.

(4) Commission for counting audience votes has 5 members and is appointed by the Organizing Board of the Festival.

(5) The Award is consisted by charter and money sum of 750,00 Euros.

(6) The charter "Award of Audience" is handed by a representative of Award sponsor.

(7) The money sum of the award is transferred by giro the latest 15 days upon completion of the Festival.

Article 8

(1) Participants' charters are handed to all choirs, conductors and members of the Festival's Jury.

(2) The charters are in printing form.

(3) Participants' charters to choirs and conductors are handed by a member of the Organizing Board of the Festival.

(4) Participants' charters to members of the Jury are handed by the President of the Artistic Council of the Festival.

Article 9

(1) Plaques, charters, medals and special recognitions are the work of designer Zoran Sovilj, whose solution has been adopted by the Organizing Board at earlier sessions.

(2) All awards, set by this Regulation, are given upon completion of third evening of the Festival in Theatre of Prijedor.

Article 10

(1) This Regulation is brought by the Mayor of the City of Prijedor based on the proposal of the Organizing Board and Artistic Council of the Festival.

(2) Amendments to this Regulation are done in the manner of its adoption.

Article 11

- (1) This Regulation shall enter into force on the eighth day upon its publication in “the Official Gazette of the City of Prijedor”.
- (2) By bringing this Regulation, the Regulations on Awards of the International Choir Festival “Zlatna vila” ceases to have effect, number 02 – 6 – 2 – 2/ 2016 which was adopted at session of the Organizing Board dated 3 February 2016.
